

What documents do I take with me to get my permit? (Information from DMV.org)

When you are 15 1/2 years old, you can apply for a learner's permit at your local DPS office as long as you either: Have completed a driver's education course **OR** are enrolled in Driver's Ed and currently receiving instruction.

- You will need to pass the written permit test, a vision exam, and provide the DPS with:
- Proof of **Primary ID** (e.g. state-certified birth certificate, valid U.S. passport, Certificate of Naturalization).
- **Secondary ID** (health insurance card, Oklahoma employer photo ID, Affidavit of Parent Authorization (Form DPS 300 PA.)
- **Social Security number** (SSN).
- **Enrollment or completion** of an approved Driver's Ed course.
- School letter verifying your enrollment in or attendance at school and that the student has passed the 8th grade reading proficiency test.
- Parent or Legal Guardian must be present with you at the DPS office as well.

** If the student is under the age of 18, they are required to hold their permit for 6 months with no tickets or wrecks.

Driver License Exam Site Hours of Operation

Attention: Closing times listed do not always reflect applicants will be accepted up to that time. Due to workloads, it may be necessary to cease taking applicants earlier in order to complete processing by the end of the business day

Attention: Hours of operation may vary. Some exam sites are staffed with one examiner. Normally for those sites, written testing is done in the morning and scheduled drive tests are conducted in the afternoon. If the examiner is out of the office conducting a drive test, phone calls will not be answered. Calling ahead, preferably in the mornings, is recommended to ensure testing availability.
